Another project allowed me to explore Java in-depth to create a fantasy zoo management system, that has potential to be turned into a tycoon or simulation type game.

For the team-project part of the course, we were tasked to create a vanilla javascript app. On top of express and webpack, we chose to use several APIs like the WebGL Earth API and a REST API for country information to provide users with an educational app.
